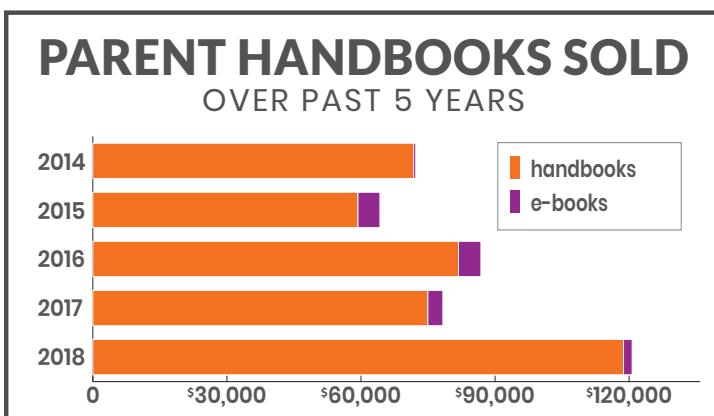



A Note from our President: 2018 was a game changing year for Operation Parent! With grants exceeding \$100,000 from generous donors including the Cralle Foundation, the Oldham County Community Foundation, Southeast Christian Church and others we were able to rebrand, redesign our website and develop an innovative prevention program designed to reach parents on their cellphones. We're now producing short, educational videos (narrated by celebrity parents) to reinforce our initiatives and reach more parents online. Our webinars are attracting a national audience exceeding 600 registrants per webinar. Our parent handbooks are being distributed locally by 20 Norton pediatric offices in Louisville (funded by a grant from CVS), school districts, and nationally through drug-free coalitions. Given our nation's current drug epidemic, it continues to be imperative to engage parents in prevention efforts. *– Jean Schumm, Operation Parent President*

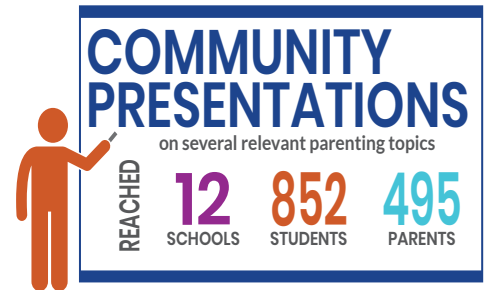

Partnered with the Kentucky Baptist Convention to develop and implement state-wide conferences focused on equipping the church to address addiction and provide resources to their community families.



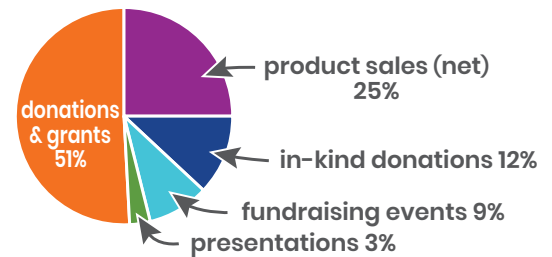

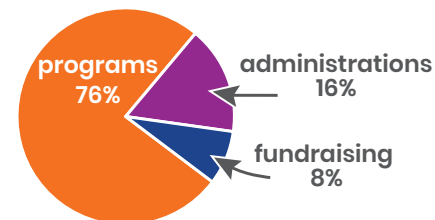
INCOME
