

## **NOTICE OF ELECTRONIC MEETING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that the **RIVER RIDGE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (“RRDA”)** will hold its Regular Board of Directors Meeting on **Wednesday, December 16, 2020, to start as close to 4:30 p.m. as possible**. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct business on essential matters critical to the operations of RRDA. Under Gov. Eric J. Holcomb’s Executive Order 20-49 – “Ninth Renewal of the Public Health Emergency Declaration for the COVID-19 Outbreak”, governmental entities are (1) allowed to conduct public meetings electronically for essential matters critical to their operations, (2) allowed to post notice of public meetings solely by electronic means when held during the health emergency, and (3) required to “make efforts to allow the public to participate electronically, if feasible”.
